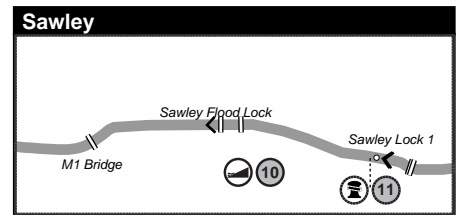
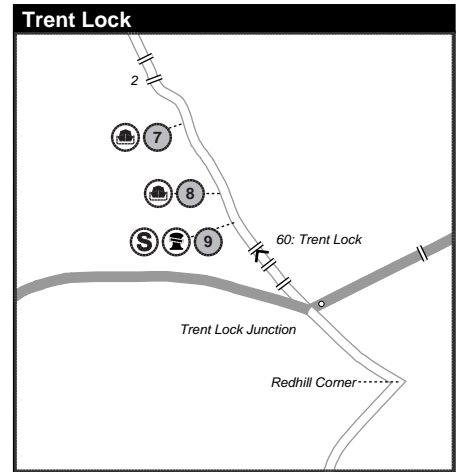
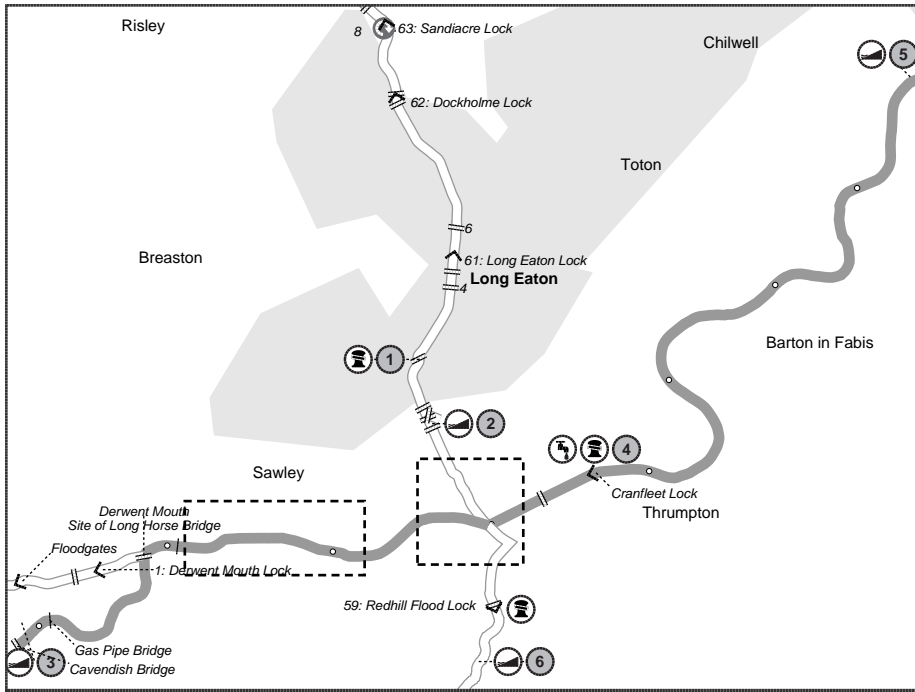

Nottingham Canal

Length 72ft (21.9m). Beam 14ft (4.2m). Headroom 8ft (2.4m). Navigation should be possible for boats of up to 81ft length and 14ft 6in beam, but please consult the waterway office first.

River Trent

In conditions of heavy rainfall, call the Environment Agency Floodline before cruising on 0845 988 1188.

Shardlow to tail of Meadow Lane Lock, Nottingham: Length 72ft (21.9m). Beam 14ft (4.2m). Headroom 8ft (2.4m). Navigation should be possible for boats of up to 81ft length and 14ft 6in beam, but please consult the waterway office first.

Trent & Mersey Canal

Shardlow to Derwent Mouth: Length 72ft (21.9m). Beam 14ft 9in (4.4m). Headroom 7ft (2.1m). Navigation should be possible for boats of up to 81ft, but please consult the waterway office first.

The width pinch point between Shardlow Locks and Derwent Mouth is the Environment Agency floodgates at Shardlow, which are 14ft 9in wide.

Non-tidal locks: (14 Apr 06 until further notice): Opening hours: 9am - 6:30pm.

Torksey Lock: (1 Oct 06 until further notice): Torksey Lock will be open from 9am until 3pm.

Cromwell Lock: (1 Oct 06 until further notice): Cromwell Lock will be open from 8am until 4pm.

Cranfleet Lock: Stoppage (8 Jan 07-16 Mar

Locks and bridges

Erewash Canal

Lock 63, Sandiacre Lock; and **Lock 62, Dockholme Lock;** and **Lock 61, Long Eaton Lock:** Erewash Canal water conservation key required.

Lock 60, Trent Lock: When leaving the canal, observe Trent Lock flood warning signs. This is a blind spot - sound horns, and check for craft coming downstream being carried by fast flowing river currents.

River Soar

Lock 59, Redhill Flood Lock: Only operates in variable water level conditions. Observe strong flow sign.

River Trent

Cavendish Bridge; and **Gas Pipe Bridge:** River Trent backwater navigation to Cavendish Bridge, Shardlow.

Site of Long Horse Bridge: This bridge over the Trent is currently missing, causing a break in the towpath.

M1 Bridge: Sawley weir nearby

Sawley Flood Lock: Windlass required. Observe strong flow warning.

Sawley Lock 1; and **Sawley Lock 2:** BW key required. Observe strong flow warning. Tel: 0115 973 5234; mob: 07717 802 543.

Cranfleet Lock: No traffic when flood gates are closed. Tel: 0115 973 2490.

9 Trent Lock: Water, Elsan disposal, toilet. Windlass, handcuff and BW keys required. Card type: AMPY.

1 Tamworth Road: Total 500 metres.

4 Cranfleet Cut: Maximum 14 Days. Total 200 metres.

9 Trent Lock: Maximum 24hrs. Total 58 metres.

11 Sawley Lock: Maximum 24hrs. Total 150 metres.

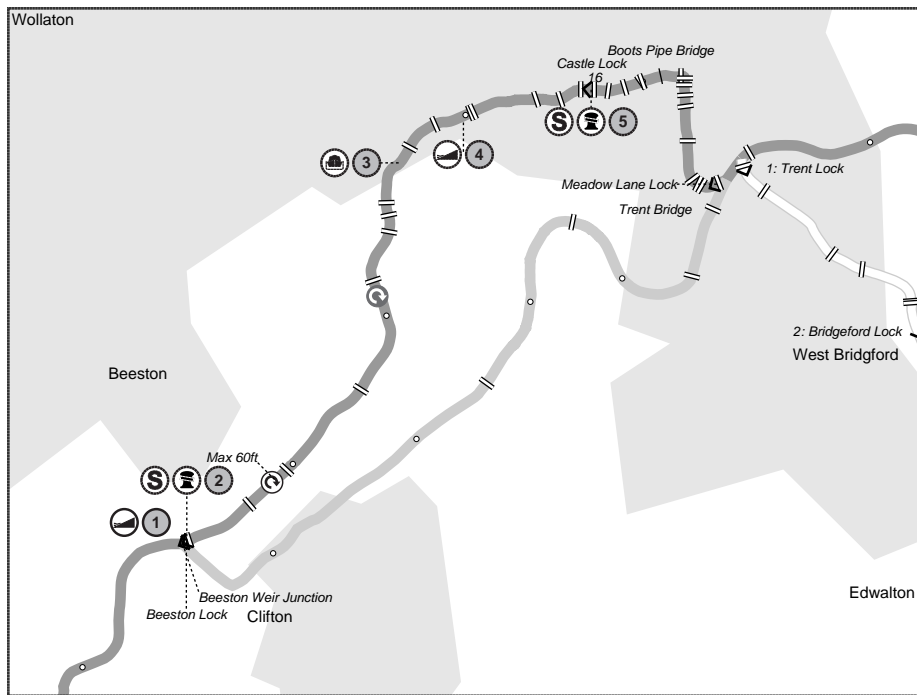

River Trent

Nottingham to tail of Cromwell Lock: Length 145ft (44.1m). Beam 18ft (5.4m). Headroom 12ft (3.6m). Draught 6ft (1.8m). Larger craft may be accommodated - for further advice, contact the waterway office. The limiting factors are the bend above Newark Nether Lock and Newark Town Bridge, not the lock chambers.

30ft. Maximum beam: 10ft. Telephone 0115 9223168. Charge will apply

3 Trevithicks Boat Yard: Slipway, dry-dock. Telephone 0115 9783467

4 Castle Marina: Slipway. Telephone 0115 9472696. Charge will apply

Boots Pipe Bridge: blocked at both ends

Meadow Lane Lock: Observe strong flow warning. Tel: 0115 986 2498.

Trent Bridge: Outside navigable stretch. Private moorings only, not in BW ownership.

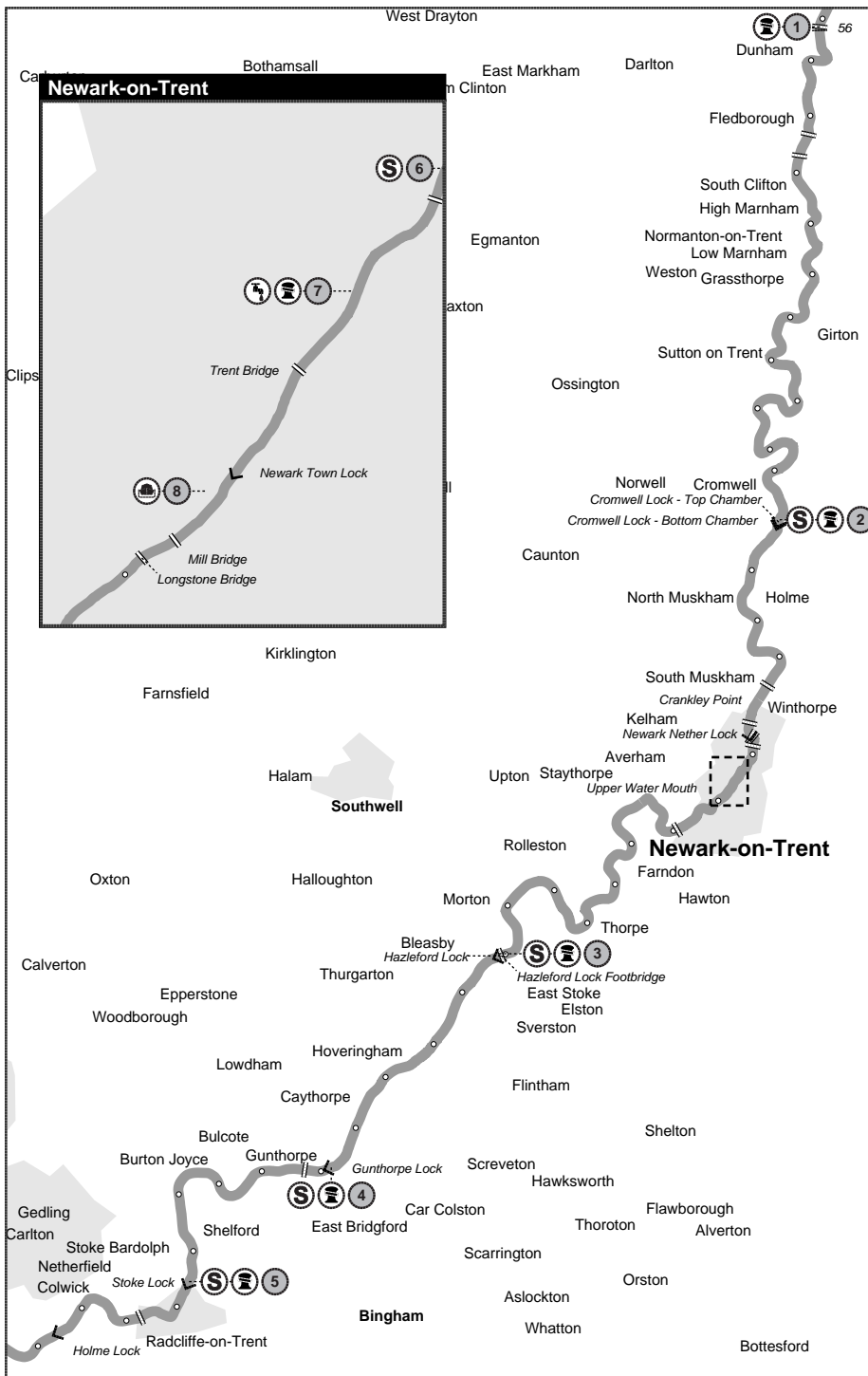

Trent Bridge: only 1 navigation arch (middle)

Newark Nether Lock: BW key required. Traffic light system in operation - moor up and check on amber light. Tel: 01636 703 830; mob: 07887 754 486.

Navigation notes

Tail of Cromwell Lock to Gainsborough: Length 185ft (56.3m). Beam 19ft (5.7m). Headroom 22ft (6.7m). Draught 5ft 6in (1.6m). Larger craft may be accommodated, depending on tidal conditions. For further advice, contact the waterway office.

Cromwell Lock to Gainsborough: Freight traffic regularly uses this section, VHF Radio Channel 6 for further information. Please note freight traffic continues past Gainsborough where the Trent is managed by Associated British Ports.

Gunthorpe Lock to Cromwell Lock: Freight traffic regularly uses this section, VHF Radio Channel 74 for further information.

Holme Lock to Gainsborough: For flood warnings and advice contact Cromwell Lock keeper on 01636 821 213

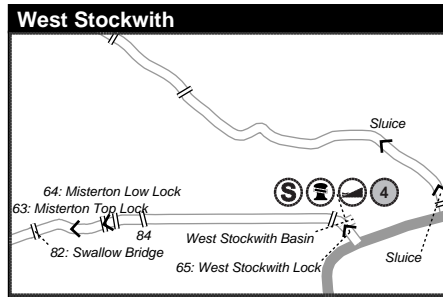
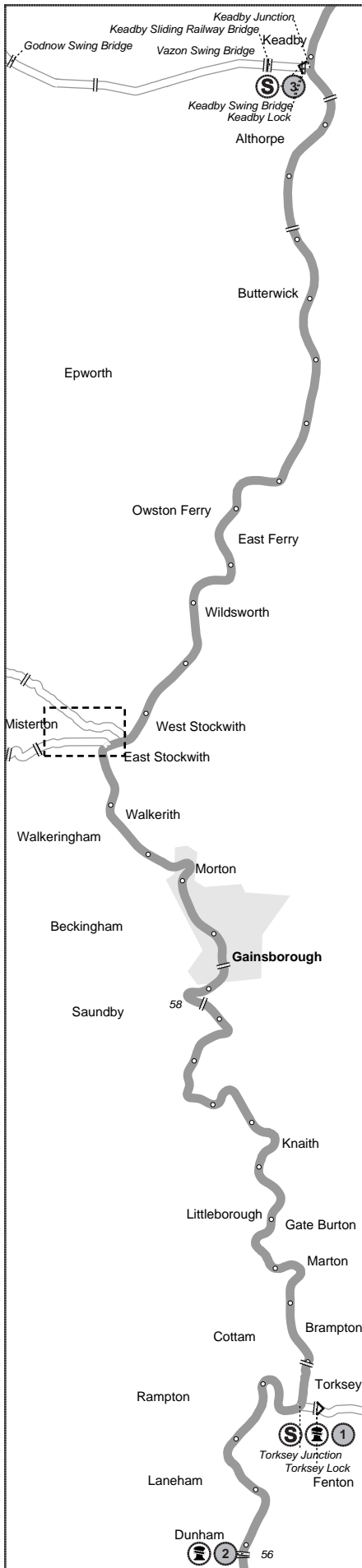

Navigation notes

Chesterfield Canal

West Stockwith to tail of Morse Lock: Length 72ft (21.9m). Beam 6ft 10in (2m). Headroom 7ft 1in (2.1m). Draught 2ft 6in (0.7m). Locks up to Retford are 15ft wide but navigation for broad-beam craft is restricted by Manor Farm Bridge at Walkeringham, which is 8ft 6in wide.

Entrance to West Stockwith Basin: Length 72ft (21.9m). Beam 16ft (4.8m). Draught 7ft (2.1m).

Sheffield & South Yorkshire Navigation

Stainforth & Keadby section: Length 61ft 8in (18.7m). Beam 17ft (5.1m). Headroom 10ft 10in (3.3m). Draught 7ft 3in (2.2m). Through passage is limited by Thorne Lock. Between Bramwith and Thorne, dimensions are as for the main line to Rotherham. Passage from the River Trent to Thorne is limited by Keadby Lock (77ft 8in x 22ft 6in) although longer craft can be admitted when the tide makes a level.

Lock 65, West Stockwith Lock: Booking details (9 Sep 03 until further notice): Passage is available 9am - 3pm NOTE: If tides as stated in the tide table booklet, fall between 7am - 9am and 3pm to 4pm, i.e outside the normal lock keeping hours, a penning can be booked providing not less than 24 hours notice is given. These locks will not be available before 7am or after 4pm. Contact: 01636 704481

Bridge 80, Cooper's Bridge: Start of SSSI

Bridge 82, Swallow Bridge: Listed bridge

Lock 63, Misterton Top Lock; and Lock 64, Misterton Low Lock: BW key required.

Lock 65, West Stockwith Lock: Care and advice must be taken when entering or leaving the Tidal Trent at West Stockwith.

West Stockwith Basin: BW key required.

Fosdyke Navigation

Torksey Lock: Lock-keeper service. The Fosdyke meets the tidal Trent here. Torksey Lock interpretation centre on site. Tel: 01427 890 204; mob: 07884 238 781.

Sheffield & South Yorkshire Navigation

Godnow Swing Bridge: BW key required. To be used in conjunction with rail crossing

Vazon Swing Bridge: BW key required.

Keadby Sliding Railway Bridge: Operated by Network Rail.

Keadby Swing Bridge: Operated by lock keeper

Keadby Lock: Operated by lock-keeper. Passage should be booked with lock keeper at least 24 hours in advance: call 07733 124611 or 01724 782205. Opening times from Easter to end Sept (approx): 6am-10am Mon-Fri, 6am-8pm Sat & Sun. Winter: 8am-4.30pm. Please follow the lock-keeper's advice on gaining access to the tidal Trent.

4 West Stockwith Lock: Water, Elsan disposal, pump-out, toilet, shower, refuse disposal. BW key required. Card type: Ampy.

1 Torksey lock: Maximum 72hrs. Total 238 metres. Please phone to arrange during lock-keeping times.
